A is for...?

Each week we will be learning about a letter of the alphabet. The first week is the letter 'A'. We will be making 'silly soup' each week and require objects and pictures beginning with the letter of the week sound. If you are able to send something in for our soup (it will be returned) beginning with the letter of the week sound, it will further support your child's learning of initial letters.

All about me - Looking at our differences and similarities and developing our self esteem by identifying what we like and what we are good at.

14th-18th : Letter B
Number 2
All about my feelings – Identifying different feelings, how we can manage our feelings and when we experience different feelings

21st-25th : Letter C
Number 3
Goldilocks and the 3 Bears –
Recalling the story through pictures and pretend play.

28th-2nd Oct : Letter D
Number 4 Goldilocks and the 3 Bears
- Developing our understanding of size.
