Could we remind parents and carers to bring in slippers for the children to wear indoors.

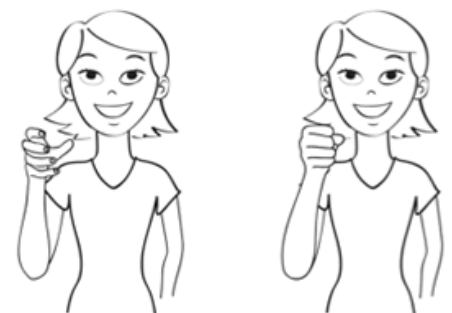
